ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Hazard Mitigation Grant Program is designed to assist communities and homeowners in reducing the impact of future disasters by funding rebuilding and strengthening projects in vulnerable areas. Available after a major disaster declaration, HMGP provides essential resources for safer, more resilient community planning.

HOW IT WORKS

- 1 **State Disaster Declaration** HMGP Funding Announced

- 2 Identify eligible projects and work with local government bodies to **submit funding applications.**

- 3 The State and FEMA will **review applications** to ensure guidelines are met.

- 4 After **approval, award funding** is passed down to state and local government to begin work.

- 5 After **project completion and closeout**, properties will be inspected and flood insurance must be purchased.
